Re: KVR Repair

On November 14th, 15th, 16th, 28th, and December 1st, 2021, the atmospheric river events destroyed much of the Tulameen River system and the KVR Trail.

My concern is for the safety of the residents who live beside the KVR and the users of the KVR. The whole community of Coalmont flooded because of the KVR being washed away and remains in danger of having floods occur again.

The residents along the Collins Gulch Road that were once protected by the KVR are now dealing with major erosion issues.

I have seen more recreational ORV users taking risks to try and go around the KVR washouts, this endangers themselves and first responders.

The KVR has been an important transportation route between Coalmont and Tulameen for tourism and it has also been used for an emergency route when the Coalmont Road was closed.

The repair of the KVR between Coalmont and Tulameen is very much needed!
